2019 Von Winning, Paradiesgarten Riesling, Pfalz Germany 23

Riesling is without question Germany's favourite grape. Widely planted, though once derided, Riesling is the superstar of the white wine world at the moment. Stone, apple, lime & typical petroleum notes. Excellent Riesling with nice minerality, high acidity & interesting finish.

2016 Andrea Oberto, Barolo DOCG, La Morra, Piemonte 33

A father & son working together producing excellent Barolo. The winery's vineyards, which are Guyot-trained on a prevalently lime/clay soil, lie in the territory of La Morra, Barolo & Cherasco. Intense & bright garnet-red, fruity aroma enhanced by a lively acidity with notes of balsamic, leather, graphite evolving with the passing of time. Complex palate, with polished tannins, evident fruity flavour & firm structure in perfect balance. Long-lasting finish.

2015 Massimo Rivetti, Froi, Barbaresco DOCG, Neive, Piemonte 30

A 5 generation family winery Massimo Rivetti has 25 hectares cultivated under organic certification with indigenous yeast & no pesticides or chemicals used. Colour is ruby red with garnet red high-lights. Full nose with violet & liquorice notes. Acid & tannins very good & well balanced. Taste is full, dry & velvety with a medium to long finish.

2016 Adalia Ruvaln Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG 35

The Ruvaln is made up of 40% Corvina, 40% Corvina Grossa & 20% Rondinella, all grown 400 meters above sea level, planted to calcareous soils. The grapes are selected by hand in the first part of October & left to naturally dry for 3 months before fermentation. Dry red wine with an intense garnet red color. The scents of sour cherries in alcohol, dried plums & tobacco stand out. Full-bodied & persistent.

Sella Vinoteca Cellar Selection

The most famous Italian wine regions are Piemonte, Toscana & Veneto, where Barolo, Barbaresco, Brunello & Amarone are made. These wines have a complexity & earthiness that reflects the soil, the unique Italian grape varieties & the craft of the winemaker. Over sixty percent of the wine grown in Italy is red wine. The cool, mountainous northern region of Piemonte produces alluring, austere & complex wines, whereas the sunny, temperate central region of Tuscany yields bold, lusty, full-bodied sensations. Over the last 5-10 years there has been a rising star, Etna Rosso from Sicilia.

Barbaresco *DOCG*

Barbaresco is Barolo's close neighbour & stylistic soul mate, both located in the Langhe region of Piemonte. Barbaresco, like Barolo, is produced from Nebbiolo grapes, but grown in Barbaresco, Treiso & Neive villages. It tends to be softer & slightly more graceful.

Barbaresco, requires aging - a minimum of two years & up to twenty years - to meet its full potential.

Big, powerful & full-bodied with a complex mixture of tastes & textures - wild strawberry, tobacco, chocolate & vanilla - Barolo gets better & better with age. Barolo is made in the Langhe hills region of Piedmont in the village of Barolo, entirely of Nebbiolo grapes.

Alto Piemonte

Just 150 kilometres to the North of the Langhe is a little known source of vibrant, mineral-laden & especially age-worthy Nebbiolo based offerings. This zone was much larger in the late 1800s & famed for its wines until the industrial revolution, world wars, phylloxera & extreme frosts drove farmers to abandon their land. Of 40,000 hectares of vineyard planted at the end of the 19th century only around 800 remain today. Rather than a single wine denomination, Alto Piemonte is a collection of ten little appellations clustered in the Northern, pre-Alpine tip of Piemonte. There are two DOCG areas; Gattinara & Ghemme, as well as eight DOCs; Lessona, Boca, Bramaterra, Fara, Sizzano, Coste della Sesia, Colline Novaresi & Valli Ossolane.

***Brunello di Montalcino* DOCG**

Montalcino is Tuscany's second most famous wine zone, after Chianti. In terms of quality, however, it is the star. Montalcino is a small, medieval town just outside of the town of Siena. The wine district there is a warm, sunny, hilly area with few extremes in temperature, the ideal conditions for grapes to ripen to their fullest. The cool evenings ensure a high acidity. Brunello di Montalcino is created entirely from Sangiovese grapes. Brunello, "the nice, dark one" in local dialect, is Tuscany's most expensive, rarest, & longest-lived wine. By Italian wine law, Brunello must be aged longer than any other wine - a minimum of four years. Brunello is subtle with overtones of blackberry, black cherry, chocolate & sweet vanilla.

***Amarone della Valpolicella* DOCG**

Amarone is made from air-dried, predominantly Corvina grapes. It is produced in the northern Veneto region near Venice, using the "appassimento" method. This technique involves picking the "ears", or those grapes that protrude at the outside of a cluster & are most exposed to the sun. The result is a bold, full-bodied wine in a style more common to warm growing areas.

***Etna Rosso* DOC**

Nerello Mascalese is an indigenous grape primarily grown on the slopes of Mount Etna in Sicily. The volcanic soil & higher altitude make this a light-bodied red wine offering amazing value & a taste profile that's often likened to fine Pinot Noir. Etna Rosso hits your mouth with an explosion of red fruit flavours that leads into spice notes of cinnamon & floral dried desert herbs.

There is always a good reason to have some nice bubbles, whether it be for an apéritif, or to pair with juicy & fresh oysters, celebrating a special event or simply just because bubbles are great!

To make it easy for you, we have split them by their style...

Charmat Method or Martinotti

With this winemaking technique the second fermentation takes place in a big & closed tank, & in one to six weeks the 'fizzy' wine is filtered & bottled with its 'dosage' (usually to a brut level). The result is a fresh fruity wine, crispy with a strong aromatic character, with fine & delicate bubbles.

Pet-nat - short for Pétillant naturel

Literally 'natural sparkling' from French, this is the oldest method (ancestral method) which basically combines the Champagne methods two fermentations into one, producing a simple & more rustic sparkling wine.

P.S. don't be deterred by it begin cloudy & pale as these wines are full of different flavours & vibrant textures that will definitely surprise & delight you!

Traditional Method - Méthod Champenoise

Many of the world's best sparkling wines are made by this method where the second fermentation takes place in the bottle, letting the yeast ferment the sugar into alcohol which gives us bubbles. Magic! After a specific aging time, usually not less than 15 months, it will result in fine & persistent bubbles, with a characteristic yeasty aroma, creamy & elegant which never fails to disappoint!
