Canberra Riesling

50-odd producers, 70-odd Rieslings in a vintage. This is just a list of highlights

2022 Ravensworth | Murrumbateman (mainly) | 80 bottle | 20 glass

A more complex creation for new vintage CBR riz; lightly cloudy, a good bit of texture from mixed ferments in ceramic egg and large format oak, but still lets the bright crisp citrusy fruit shine and acid grip in.

2021 Eden Road | Murrumbateman | 85 bottle

Soft and approachable in every sense. Makes it dangerously drinkable. Soft blossom and lemon pith nose, citrus dominant palate but restraint giving it a really good point of difference from most new vintage CBR Riesling.

2022 Clonakilla | Murrumbateman | 80 bottle

Power and finesse, like all Clonakilla wines. Kaffir lime skin and delicate floral notes on the nose, clean and dry. Bouncy acidity and long lime juice and lemon pith tickle the palate, and a really fine texture makes it a class-topper for 2022.

2022 Mount Majura | Majura | 75 bottle | 18 glass

Juicy lime and lemon palate with secondary granny smith. Superbly balanced, dry and a long zingy finish. Excellent power and balance, will develop nicely over time but for now enjoys a podium finish for CBR 2022's in our eyes.

2022 Long Rail Gully | Murrumbateman | 60 bottle | 15 glass

A light and aromatic style, with a hint of stone fruit on the nose and crisp fresh lime juice on the palate. A clean lingering finish. Exceptional value.

2022 Helm *Premium* | Murrumbateman | 95 bottle

Melon and salts on the nose, super clean palate, crisp fine acid with a slight salinity. Long palate, the length is supreme, coupled with a slippery texture.

2022 Gallagher | Jeir | 75 bottle | 18 glass

Deep, flinty lemon curd and lime juice cordial characters, both on the nose and palate. A Canberra classic. In absolute harmony; ripe fruit, acidity, length and concentrated palate. A brilliant Riesling, once again.

2015 Lark Hill *back-vintage* | Bungendore | 150 bottle

A cracker year, great producer, classic Canberra Rizla with citrus and now an added complexity from age. Fine acid wrapped all through the palate. Holding the dry CBR's back a bit adds an incredible depth, and this ones worthy of a few mores set aside if we had more (or any!) storage.

2022 Lake George Winery | Lake George, CBR | 70 bottle

Spankin dry Riesling made by Nick O'leary. Apple sherbet on the nose, popping acidity throughout the palate with a nostalgic burst of sour apple warhead and limey coatings throughout.

2022 Nick O'Leary *Heywood* | Hall | 80 bottle

Our favourite of Nick's Rieslings. Single site out at Hall, already developing stonefruit and pear characters which sets it apart from his baseline Riz.

2022 Helm *Half Dry* | Murrumbateman | 60 bottle | 15 glass

'Halbtrocken' as the great man calls it; lifted pineapple, tropical notes nose followed up with lemon, mandarin, honey, spice, lightly sweet. Phenomenal value bet from the local legend.

Aussie Riesling

Some absolute winners from interstate

2021 Schwarz Wine Co. | Eden Valley, SA | 70 bottle

A lovely little number from Eden Valley. Apple sherbet on the nose, tight citrus and crunchy green pear palate. Zippy acidity. Delicious way to start.

2019 Sons of Eden *Cirrus* Single Vineyard | Eden Valley, SA | 95 bottle

Vibrant and bursting with citrus; lemon, grapefruit and kaffir lime leaf. Minerally, refined, balanced. The epitome of Eden Riz.

2021 Miss Zilm | Clare Valley, SA | 65 bottle | 16 glass

Pale green gives a hint to the amount of lime juice aromas about to whack you in the chops. Vibrant citrus, tight acidity, good pure fruit, and a long dry full finish. Beauty for her first solo endeavor.

2016 Clos Clare | Clare Valley, SA | 90 bottle

What would the Barry family know about Riesling? Everything. From a patch adjoining the famous 'Florita' vineyard comes this classic-shaped Clare. Lemon and lime on the nose, balanced citrus and acidity throughout the palate. Another beauty and a bargain for the quality.

2019 Loosen-Barry *Wolfta Wolfta* | Clare Valley, SA | 210 bottle

A marriage of 'royal' families; the Barry's from Clare and the Loosen's from Mosel in Germany. The result? A spectacular example of Clare Riesling, but not the same-same. Large format oak adds layer on layer of complexity. Ripe lime and white nectarine on the nose and palate, secondaries of tropical fruits and delicate herbs. Finishing with incredibly fine texture. Once in a lifetime stuff.

2022 Grosset *Polish Hill* Riesling | Clare Valley, SA | 240 magnum

An aussie classic, right at the pinnacle of bone-dry Riesling from the Clare. Citrus on citrus nose, with secondaries of floral and melon notes. Super wine.

2013 Frankland Estate *Poison Hill* | Frankland River, WA | 170 bottle

Totally deserving of its reputation as one of Australia's finest sites for Riesling. Still incredibly fresh with deceptive acid levels lurking behind the lemon curd and fresh lemon pith palate. An aged beauty.

2021 Rocky Gully Riesling | Frankland River, WA | 65 bottle | 16 glass

A light, bright, refreshing Riesling. Warm lime skin and floral notes, backed up by prancing citrus medley on the palate. Good acid, good balance, good length. Cracking wine for the price.

2021 Robert Stein *Reserve* | Mudgee, NSW | 105 bottle

Super fine, flinty citrus nose. Power and finesse on the palate, crisp cut lime and subtle fennel seed aromas during your sips. Acid is really tight without being aggressive. A very fine beverage indeed.

2019 Stargazer *Palisander* Vineyard | Coal River Valley, Tas | 135 bottle

Steely nose, fresh light citrus, followed by a perfectly balanced palate; not overly dry or sweet. A melody of citrus from lime juice to fresh orange oil. One of the top Tassie Rieslings.

2020 Dr. Edge *North* | Tamar Valley, Tas | 90 bottle

9 months on lees, its fragrant, fleshy floral and effing fantastic. Preserved lemon and grapefruit are super dense through the palate, leading to a dry and chalky textural finish. Quirky and incredible.

International Rieslings

The old world gets pretty worked up about who 'owns' Riesling. The Germans, the Austrians, the French. For us: who cares? Just drink the stuff. Its good.

2020 Loosen Dr. L | Mosel, Germany | 65 bottle | 16 glass

Charred pineapple and subtle lychee on the nose. Vibrant palate with tight acidity and sweet tropical fruit. Balanced and extremely smashable. Bargain. Not the Mosel of old, thankfully.

2020 Vollenweider *Felsenfest* | Mosel, Germany | 90 bottle

A classic dry style Riesling, zippy and tight acidity. Crunchy green apple, lime and peach notes, with a lick of minerality. Produced in a Grand Cru site, an incredible steal, grab it while its hot.

2019 Joh Jos Prum *Wehlener Sonnenuhr* Spatlese | Mosel, Germany | 185 bottle

Impossibly well balanced Spatlese. High sugar intertwined around a fine acid line, an abundance of tropical fruits from honeydew and pineapple through to nectarine and white cherry. Phenomenal stuff.

2020 Donnhoff *Kreuznacher Kahlenberg GG Trocken* | Nahe, Germany | 165 bottle

Crisp tropical aromas, think pawpaw, ripe pineapple, lemon oil. Palate wise dominated by lemon and salinity from the flinty soils, exceptionally dry.

2021 Domane Wachau *Federspiel* | Wachau, Austria | 80 bottle

Peach and apricot on the palate, with a lick of citrus. Awesome minerality from the marble soil adding salinity that rounds out the acidity. High altitude for a cool climate wine, situated in Spitzer Graben.

2017 Brundlmeyer *Ried Heiligenstein 1er Lyra* | Kamptal, Austria | 230 bottle

Earthy, lemony, leesy goodness from Kamptal. Its dry and has developed nicely over time in bottle, will also reward drinking closer to room temp and slowly to let it open up. One of the finest Rieslings we've ever had.

2013 Stadt Krems *Grillenparz 1er* | Kremstal, Austria | 145 bottle

Rich oily nose with hints of lemon peel. Juicy citrus and apricot on the palate, with controlled texture. Limestone soils result in a clean finish and acid structure rarely seen in Rieslings of this age. Outstanding.

2019 Willm *Reserve* | Alsace, France | 75 bottle | 18 glass

Light green in the glass, lush nose with honey, stonefruit and floral notes. Generous fruit weight without being flabby. Good lingering acidity. Hint of age.

2019 Barmes-Buecher *Steingrubler* Grand Cru | Alsace, France | 185 bottle

Almost a bit nutty on the nose, hazelnut and almond, alongside minerality and white peach. A lush texture offsets this a roaring acidity. It finishes on a pleasantly minerally clean note. Complex and brilliant.

2019 Domaine Kirrenbourg *Granitique* | Alsace, Fra | 115 bottle

Zesty lemon on the nose and straw yellow in the glass. Plenty more citrus on the palate; lemon and grapefruit and hints of green apple. Dry, clean savoury.

2018 Rippon *Mature Vine* | Central Otago, New Zealand | 110 bottle

Ripe, plush and complex Riesling. A beautiful balance to it; richer stone and melon characters, signs of ageing veering to ripe fruit on the palate with soft acidity over a slight viscosity. Beautifully crafted.

Tim's Page

Who is Tim? Tim is your mate. You know? The fella with discerning taste, loves dry wines with a bit of a backstory or a bit of age on them. Or both. He's keen for a chat, and knows heaps more about wine than Andy. So here's to you Tim – enjoy some speccy's ordered in with you in mind.

2015 Lark Hill *back-vintage* | Bungendore, Canberra District | 150 bottle

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2019 Yeringberg *Viognier* | Yarra Valley, Vic | 125 bottle

Textured, layered wine with a tonne of character from sharp citrus to dried apricot and almond nougat. Secondary notes of fennel seed and candied citrus peel. Complex, curious, and even better closer to room temp. Awesome.

2018 Eden Road *Block 71 Cullarin* Syrah | Lake George, CBR | 90 bottle

Shiraz exclusively from the first vineyard ever planted in the district on the verge of Lake George. Pristine quality fruit, all red and blue, light Sichuan pepper through the palate. Fine french oak is evident. Phenomenal length and finish.

*We've got a little stash of some back vintage Loosen GG's, Brundlmeyers, and multiple vintages of Lark Hill estate Riesling too but not kept cold.
We'll chat and give us 30mins to get them chilled..*

Other white wines do exist.

A select list of whites that aren't Riesling that are definitely worth sharing

2022 Linear Gruner Veltliner | Tumbarumba, NSW | 70 bottle

Soft beurre bosc pear and white pepper on the nose, supreme balance of acid, sugar and fruit. A delicious beverage, and a proper love child of Riesling & pinot Gris.

2018 Lark Hill Gruner Veltliner | Bungendore, Canberra District | 130 bottle

Dry Melon, white pepper and complexity from time in oak and in bottle, a real thinker's white. Pioneers here in Canberra and recognized as one of the country's best GV producers.

2020 Domaine Marcel Deiss *Complantation* | Alsace, France | 115 bottle

A blend of the 13 white/grey grapes grown in the region. Don't ask what's in it - that's not the point, its all about the terroir. Complex, silky mouthfeel, textural. Straw in colour, all round pleaser, with notes of honeydew, lychee, pear, pineapple and pink grapefruit. Along with all the rest.

2022 Clonakilla Viognier *Nouveau* | Murrumbateman | 75 bottle | 18 glass

Profoundly aromatic; fresh herbs, granny smith and pear. Dry and delicious, plenty of crunchy apple on the palate, subtle stonefruit chasers. Super smashable, fresh booze.

2020 Monte Carbonare Soave | Suavia, Italy | 120 bottle

100% Garganega from pure black volcanic soils, and it sure does show. Earthy and textural dry white. Light citrus, apple blossom, nectarine wrapped around tight acidity. Minerality for dayyyys. Absolute knockout from a cult producer.

2019 Burn Cottage Riesling + Gruner Veltliner | Central Otago, NZ | 125 bottle

Dry style blend, rich savoury and dense. Super long, grippy finish. Layered and complex apple, citrus and Chinese five spice on the palate. Another wine we wish we were drinking ourselves.

2020 Mac Forbes Villages Chardonnay | Woori Yallock, Vic | 85 bottle | 21 glass

From the 'Woori Yallock' vineyard, this chardonnay is super complex, a touch of oak and flinty minerality adding to the texture. Think orange zest and grapefruit with tight acid. An outstanding drop.

2019 Yeringberg Viognier | Yarra Valley, Vic | 125 bottle

Textured, layered wine with a tonne of character from sharp citrus to dried apricot and almond nougat. Secondary notes of fennel seed and candied citrus peel. Complex, curious, and even better closer to room temp. Awesome.

2019 Mount Mary Chardonnay | Yarra Valley, Vic | 195 bottle

A big dawg of the Australian Chardonnay scene. A cacophony of classic chardonnay notes on the nose; citrus, pear, peach and cashew goodness. Pear follows, with yellow grapefruit and then a nice buttery piece of toast on the palate. Kinda like breakfast. An iconic, premium Aussie Chardonnay, exceptional length and depth.

The Fizz

Good before, good during, good after

2021 Gilbert *Pet-Nat* Riesling | Central Ranges, NSW | 70 bottle | 17 glass

Crispy and minimal funk. Cloudy apple cider to the eye, green apple and lime on the nose and palate, mouth-filling fizz. Delicious. GT Young Winemaker of the Year 2021.

NV Gallagher *Duet* | Jeir, Canberra District | 65 bottle | 16 glass

Pinot Noir and Chardonnay *method traditionnelle* with citrus, pear and a light toastiness from time with yeast. Great local bubbles. Simple, clean, balanced.

2021 Mac Forbes *Rizz Fizz* Pet-Nat | Strathbogie Ranges, Vic | 80 bottle

Stinky natty nose might make you think its going to be a carbonic, grippy monster. But fret not – the palate is super clean and lively with a persistent mousse. Crispy citrus, flinty, bubble AF. Summertime.

NV Swift *Cuvee Brut* | Orange, NSW | 110 bottle | 22 glass

Made from two different crops of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, blended post fermentation for consistency. Delicious strawberry notes, with pronounced licks of brioche and nuttiness. Richness from 5 years on lees. An outstanding bubbles, definitely rivals the big champagne houses, most like Bolly if anything. Patient, generous, delicious.

NV Billecart-Salmon *Brut Nature* | Champagne, Fra | 175 bottle

A new one to their impressive stable. For me its like a cross with my other fave; Bolly. Its richer in style than the cristal clear intensity of the above, more honey'on'toast and brioche, nutty notes. An absolute killer.

Rose

Pretty, pretty dry, and pretty good with arvo sunshine

2020 Commanderie de Preissan | Pays D'oc, Fra | 75 bottle | 18 glass

Salmon pink, and a classic dry style southern French rose. Strawberries and cream and redcurrants on the nose and palate, a little more complex than your average Provence style but still refreshing and quaffable.

2020 Domaine Sainte-Marie | Provence, France | 75 bottle

Classic Provence style rose. Grenache based. Dry and super pretty, strawberries and cream with secondary raspberry and watermelon on the palate. An absolute belter in the sun.

2021 Gundog *Indomitus Rosa* | Hilltops, NSW | 85 bottle

Dried cranberries and currants mixed with spice on the nose and followed by a beautifully balanced dry palate with red fru it and floral tones. 100% Nebbiolo from near Young, NSW. A standout rose.

2020 Charles Melton *There's a Rose in Spanish Harlem* | Barossa, SA | 70 bottle

Can be served chilled or room temp. This straddles the void between Rose and red. Blended and effectively a non-vintage wine grabbing reserve parcels of reds from the past few vintages and turning out a total curiosity; deep ruby colour, spicy and complex. Redcurrant over flower petals with a super clean

mouthfeel. Like I said; kinda like a light red.

Reds – from light to heavy

2021 Linear Gamay | Tumbarumba, NSW | 80 bottle

A super pretty and clean light red. White cherry and vanilla on the nose and palate, juicy with a tingle of spice and a neat finish.

2021 Linear Pinot Noir | Tumbarumba, NSW | 70 bottle | 17 glass

Distinct deep fleshy red cherry on the nose with a hint of savouriness. Cherry and red plum again on the palate, with a complex of smoky nuttiness. Super fine tannin. Well balanced.

2017 Rippon Mature Vine Pinot Noir | Central Otago, NZ | 195 bottle

Maybe the lightest Central Otago Pinot I've ever encountered. Elegant in every way; perfumed nose, light clean palate balanced from start to finish. Gets a bit heavier the longer its opened.

2020 SC Pannell Aglianico | McLaren Vale, SA | 80 bottle | 20 glass

Cherry and black pepper on the nose, juicy yet dry. Lingers long and delicate. The epitome of light dry red from McLaren Vale. Aglianico loiters somewhere between a Pinot and Shiraz and this is smack dab in the middle. Delish.

2021 Aller Trop Loin Nero D'Avola | Heathcote, Vic | 75 bottle | 18 glass

Bright cherry and plum on the front of the palette. Chalky tannins give a generous savory finish. A wine best paired with food.

2018 Quarry Hill Shiraz | Murrumbateman, CBR | 65 bottle | 16 glass

Ruby red and bursting with red fruit and pepper spice on the nose. Supple weight, classic medium bodied CBR shiraz, nice secondary spice characters. A seriously easy drinking red.

2021 Nanima Road Pinot Noir + Shiraz | Springrange, CBR | 75 bottle | 18 glass

50% Pinot 50% Shiraz, cool climate wine. Rich fruits like fig, cranberry, plum, velvety mouth feel with a hint of oak, super moorish.

2017 Charles Melton *Voices of Angels* Shiraz | Adelaide Hills, SA | 210 bottle

The addition of 4% Riesling adds a little extra aromatic and acid to the nose and overall structure. Brilliant length, supple fruit, structured and elegant.

2017 Lark Hill *Scuro* Sangiovese + Shiraz | Murrumbateman, CBR | 130 bottle

A blend of Sangiovese and Shiraz grown on Lark Hill's *Dark Horse Vineyard* at Murrumbateman. Rich, intense, dark and generous.

2018 Eden Road *Block 71 Cullarin* Syrah | Lake George, CBR | 90 bottle

Shiraz exclusively from the first vineyard ever planted in the district on the verge of Lake George. Pristine quality fruit, all red and blue, light Sichuan pepper through the palate. Fine french oak is evident. Phenomenal length.

2018 Indigo *Hannahford* Cabernet Blend | Beechworth, Vic | 75 bottle

Deep reddish with slight bricking to the eye means its good to go. Ooooh gee that's a nice nose. Cassis and raspberry and fine tannins on the palate, good grip on the mid palate without being chewy.

Dessert style Rieslings

From beautifully light, to thick and rich, sweet style Rieslings can do anything! Listed here from least to most residual sugar. 375ml bottles, 75ml glasses unless indicated.

2021 Murrumbateman Winery Kay's | Murrumbateman, CBR | 85 bottle | 15 glass

Distinctly off-dry, a sweetness across the palate balanced by light acidity to start and a lingering minerality. Grapefruit and pineapple having a good ol' boogie for quite a while. Definitely on the sweet side. **750ml bottle, 75ml glass.**

2022 Lark Hill *Ley-Line* | Bungendore, Canberra District | 125 bottle | 18 glass

Pale green in the glass, totally deceptive of the power and purity to come. Intense lemon and candied lime peel on the nose, lifted floral notes, with a super fine acidity and sweetness. Phenomenally well balanced little dessert wine. **750ml bottle, 75ml glass.**

2017 Ridgeside Winery Vidal *Icewine* | Ontario, Canada | 80 bottle

The real deal. Proper Icewine from Niagara Peninsula, Ontario. One of the coldest regions for wine in the world, its pressed at minus 8 celsius. Rich apricot and nutty aromas, powerful honey sweetness. Liquid gold.

2021 Mount Horrocks *Cordon Cut* | Clare Valley, SA | 90 bottle

Dense and concentrated thanks to the cane-cut process. Juicy citrus, spring florals and spice. Impressively sweet and long, yet acidity prevents cloy.

2016 Dr. Loosen *Eiswein* | Mosel, Germany | 200 bottle

The real deal; vibrant and racy wine produced from Riesling grapes frozen solid on the vine and picked in the early hours and pressed while still frozen. Juicy and sweet with a crisp acid finish.

2017 JJ Prum *Wehlener Sonnenuhr Auslese* | Mosel, Germany | 150 bottle

Dense and concentrated. Raisin and crispy citrus on the nose give way to stonefruit and white cherry on the palate. Incredible booze. Still has a zippy acid backbone underneath all that fleshy goodness.

2019 Donnhoff *Niederhauser Hermannshohle Auslese* | Nahe, Germany | 180 Bottle

Precise and delicate, this is the Nahe deepend right here. An incredibly light palate weight to carry a crisp, sweet tropical fruit punch without the cloying stickiness of a 'sticky'. Really next level stuff.
